

Cambridgeshire SRA League Constitution

1) Control

Organisation and control of the Cambs SRA leagues and league cup tournaments shall be exercised by the County Committee and General Meetings using the rules below.

2) Structure

The Cambs SRA leagues will be structured in 2 sections

- a) Mens section consisting ideally of 6 divisions with 10 teams each.
- b) Womens section consisting ideally of 3 divisions of 10 teams each

3) Subscriptions

Subscriptions are payable annually by 1st October at the following rates per team per season.

- a) Mens section – clubs affiliated to Cambs SRA - £30
- b) Mens section – clubs not affiliated to cambs SRA - £40
- c) Womens section – clubs affiliated to Cambs SRA - £30
- d) Womens section – clubs not affiliated to Canbs SRA - £40
- e) SRA Cup, Hereward, Perpetual cups – included in league subscription

4) Annual Meetings

An annual meeting will be held in conjunction with but not part of the Cambs SRA AGM. At least 21 days notice of the meeting shall be given in writing to the nominated team representative. The following business shall be transacted-

- a) Approval of minutes of previous AM
- b) Consideration of any matters arising there from.
- c) League and Cup admin including subscription levels
- d) Any other business of which notice had been given to the section League Secretary not less than 14 days prior to the meeting viz-

Application for league membership
Disciplinary matters
Amendments to League & Cup rules
Proposals for league positions

Any other business at the discretion of the Chairperson.

5) Voting rights at an AM

General matters

One vote per team representing a club affiliated to the Cambs SRA

Mens section matters

One vote per Mens section team representing a club affiliated to the Cambs SRA

Womens section matters

One vote per Ladies section team representing a club affiliated to the Cambs SRA

NB Teams representing clubs not affiliated to the Cambs SRA have no voting rights at the AM

6) Voting

Voting shall be by show of hands unless, before a vote is taken, the Chairperson or three persons present and entitled to vote may demand a ballot.

7) Amendments

No addition or alteration of this constitution and attached rules shall be made unless passed by a two-thirds majority of the total persons present and entitled to vote at the AM
