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RULES OF THE CAMBS SRA LEAGUE CUP COMPETITIONS

- 1) All clubs playing in the Cambridgeshire SRA leagues are automatically entered into the Knock-out competitions. Clubs in Men's Division 1 or 2 play in the Light Blue Travel Cup. Clubs with first teams competing in Men's Division 3 and below play in the Endersby Cup. Ladies club teams play in the Portway Perpetual Cup.
- 2) Where a specific match date is not given clubs drawn at home are expected to play their Cup game on their normal home match night during that week.
- 3) Matches will consist of five rubbers, each rubber being the best of five games.
- 4) Teams must be played in strict order of merit without violating any team order existing within the league at that time.
- 5) Player eligibility
 - a) Players may only play in the rounds preceding the quarter final stage if they have played at least once in the current season for their club in the Cambridgeshire SRA Leagues. This rule does not apply for preliminary round matches.
 - b) Players may only play in the quarterfinal stage if they have played at least twice in the current season for their club in the Cambridgeshire SRA Leagues.
 - c) Players may only play in the semi-final stage if they have played at least three times in the current season for their club in the Cambridgeshire SRA Leagues.
 - d) Players may only play in the final stage if they have played at least four times in the current season for their club in the Cambridgeshire SRA Leagues.
- 6) Dunlop SRA approved double yellow spot squash balls must be used unless agreed by both Captains.
- 7) All Cup results should be sent, within two days of the match and on a normal match result card, to the League Secretary.
- 8) Any problems, disputes or appeals should be referred as quickly as possible to the League Secretary as shown with the draw.
