PLAYER CONDUCT REPORT FORM

Notes:

Referees will appreciate that it is not appropriate for action to be taken by England Squash in relation to individual relatively minor incidents of misbehaviour or non-compliance with the Rules of the Game. However, the Association is determined to uphold standards and will not only act on individual cases of serious misconduct, but will also impose penalties on regular offenders of a smaller degree. Hence this form.

It is essential that every England Squash member completes and returns a form to England Squash when forced to impose conduct penalties **WHATEVER THE EVENT OR LEAGUE AND CALIBRE OF PLAYER CONCERNED.**

The System:

Players will accumulate penalty points for each conduct offence:

Stroke, 1 Game, 3

NB: (1) Only the most serious infringement in a single match shall be used for the purpose of points accumulation.

(2) There is no penalty point provision for disqualification, as this would be dealt with by the England Squash Disciplinary Panel on an individual basis.

Players will invoke automatic bans for reaching the following levels in calendar year:

A Game awarded against - One Week*

7 points accumulated - One Month

An additional 3 points (over 7) accumulated in the same year - One further month

If a player is subjected to two bans in a two year period a further sanction may be made by the England Squash Disciplinary Panel.

Less than 7 points in one year, but a combined ten point total in the subsequent year will attract a two week ban.

- This will be added to any other sanction, which a player may attract.

A ban would prohibit a player from competing in any England Squash Sanctioned Event or Metropolitan/County/National League during the period concerned.

Any bans will commence on the third Monday after the date of the conduct offence, which caused the ban to be imposed. However all periods of bans will fall within the months October – April and may be carried over if necessary.
